Especially regarding topics under federal jurisdiction, such as youth, RCMP, oversight, wrongful convictions, supreme court appointments, corrections service of Canada, etc. – 20 min

- 8) Discussion question 3: What would an accountability mechanism for Government regarding the NIJS implementation look like? How do we make the NIJS stable and not subject to changes in government? – 30 min

(For example the Criminal Code, the Youth Justice Act, the judicial appointment process, etc.) How can the parallel process occurring under the United Nations Declaration Act support the NIJS implementation? 30 min
